Community Supported Agriculture ("CSA") is a fantastic way to connect people to a small local farm, build community, and get excellent quality naturally-grown vegetables. CSA members support the farm by paying a portion of the season's expenses in advance; the farmers then grow, harvest, and wash the produce, delivering it to a convenient pick-up spot (the Christ Episcopal Church in Ballston Spa). Members come each Tuesday (4pm to 7pm) from June 13th through October 23rd (20 weeks total) to collect their share into their own bags. There are also several "farm days" each season when everyone's invited to the farm for an (optional) morning of work, a tour, and a potluck meal.
